NCLP has an exciting new position to work on a new project focussing on people who face challenges in getting into work, and support them to move closer towards education, training, volunteering or employment.

The Building Better Opportunities (BBO) Herefordshire Project Community Mentor role is jointly funded by the Big Lottery fund and the European Social Fund. It is managed by Landau and as one of the Delivery Partners; we now need to recruit a Community Mentor for the lifetime of this two year project.

Target BBO Herefordshire Project participants are Women, Addictions, Over 50s, Rural, Disability, Learning Disability, Carers, Black and Minority Ethnic, Homeless, Mental Health, and Unemployed.

The successful candidate will provide intensive day to day 1:2:1 support to BBO Herefordshire Project participants to build their stability, confidence, motivation and readiness to learn, and ultimately move them closer towards education, training, volunteering or work, including self-employment. Own car essential as County-wide travel is necessary to service the contract.
